
Treehouse





Clear Sky has implemented a new program this year called the "Treehouse". The Treehouse is a place where students learn about many things including identifying and expressing feelings; how actions impact self and others; how to solve problems; how to calm down; and how to use positive coping skills. Students visit the Treehouse for regularly scheduled groups to learn and practice skills that help them succeed in the classroom. Students also visit the Treehouse when they are having a hard time being "ready to learn". They may be moving too slowly, starting to lose control or out of control. In these situations the Treehouse is a great place for students to get some extra support to figure out what they need to regroup and return to class.

The Treehouse is staffed full-time by Stacy Wheelus who greets the students and supports them in utilizing tools and small group learning. Through this work, Stacy partners with our School Psychologist, Lauren Bennett. Stacy applied for and was awarded a grant from Westerra Credit Union to help provide therapeutic and sensory tools that students learn how to utilize appropriately. The Treehouse has benefited many students by providing them with a safe place to meet emotional and sensory needs instead of using the health room or front office. We are excited to have the Treehouse as a part of our school this year!



Teachers and Technology Program

As we come to the end of this calendar year, we hope you and your families get a chance to enjoy the holidays and reflect on all that is important and meaningful to you. As members of the PTO, one thing that is important to us is providing fun, meaningful, memory-filled activities for our students and school community. We enjoy what we do, and hope that you have had a chance to participate in some of the fun activities that your Clear Sky PTO has planned and facilitated so far this school year.

In addition to the activities and events outside of school, the PTO works hard to make sure that our students and teachers have great experiences during school. Due to the success of our various fundraisers (thanks to YOU!), the PTO has already been able to distribute funds back to the students and classrooms this year in multiple ways:

\$300 given to each classroom teacher (for a total of \$9300) at the beginning of the year to be used for Project **Based Learning**

\$8000 given to the school to offset the cost of the Avid 4 Adventure outdoor learning experience

\$7500 given to the school for use specifically for Guided Reading books and materials for literacy focus

\$215 for literacy items to support our ELL (English Language Learner) students

\$550 for 6th grade science learning \$440 for 1st grade literacy enhancement \$300 to build a classroom library

\$120 for items for our new Treehouse area

\$150 for vocabulary curriculums

\$450 for equipment for the CSE Photography Club

As you can see, your efforts are creating wonderful experiences and opportunities for your students. As we have mentioned many times this year already, none of this is possible without all of you.
